A Simple Test for Chinch Bugs -

Dry grass in your lawn could be chinch bug damage. Cut both ends from a metal can, place it in the ground in the damaged area, fill the can with water and look for small, dark insects to float to the surface. If you notice chinch bugs, treat the area immediately.

Some tasks require a specialist. Most materials are available. If you can help us out call Guy Chason or Geno.

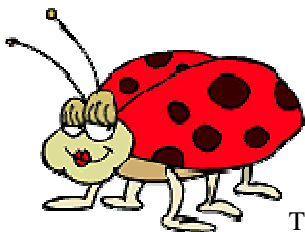
